We wrote a movie. Actually, we wrote a lot of movies, but let's stay focused. After *City Slickers*, Billy Crystal (you've heard of him) suggested that we collaborate again on a movie the three of us would co-write based on a character Billy had created years before—a comedian named Buddy Young, Jr. We did. It was called *Mr. Saturday Night*. It was released 30 years ago and it was (and is) one of our favorite things we've ever done. Unfortunately, it was not a box office smash. As Yogi Berra (supposedly) said, "If people don't want to come, you can't stop them."

But then, around seven years ago, Billy floated the idea of breathing life back into Buddy by way of a Broadway musical. This was an area of show business in which we had very little—okay, no—experience. But loving the character as we do and wanting him to find the audience we felt he deserved, the three of us dug in. We were then provided with many gifts. They were named Jason Robert Brown (music), Amanda Green (lyrics) and John Rando (director). These people had a great advantage over us. They actually knew what they were talking about. Together we all created a new journey for Buddy with deeper relationships expressed through story, character, words and music.

One of our first thoughts was, "What would be the cruelest insult that could befall an older comic in the twilight of a mediocre career?" So while watching the Emmy Awards on TV, Buddy discovers himself included in the In Memoriam segment. Now we were off and running.

We also began to explore more fully Buddy's relationships. His wife, Elaine, who is a human life jacket. His brother and ex-manager, Stan, with whom he has a somewhat dysfunctional relationship. And his daughter, Susan, with whom he has a completely dysfunctional relationship.

We watch Buddy desperately try to use the false report of his death as a springboard to restarting his career. We learn about his early start

as a comedian, the beginning of his love affair with Elaine and all the greatness his talent seemed to promise.

But Buddy is just not wired for long-term success. An obstacle keeps getting in his way—him.

Eventually, at his darkest moment (during which he is—remarkably—still funny), Annie, a young agent, decides Buddy is too funny for show business to seal him in a barrel and dump him in a lake. She determines to save Buddy's career. An opportunity arises for Buddy to audition for the lead role in a major film.

The pressure of this opportunity actually serves to intensify the dysfunction between Buddy and Susan, and Susan's anger even spills onto Elaine.

At the audition, Buddy discovers that the part he was hoping to get has actually already been cast, and he is asked to audition for a lesser role. After giving an excellent reading, he blows up, becomes abusive, sabotages himself as he has done several times in his life and storms out. Stan chases him, and after 50 years Stan finally boils over. Stan's anger has a profound effect on Buddy. Shaken, he makes a sincere attempt to reconcile with Susan and later with Stan. Buddy, in his own words, has had a "nervous put-together."

And the world rewards him with a great opportunity.

In the movie, we left Buddy with a victory over himself but not a show business triumph. However, for the musical we chose an unambiguously happy ending. Because theater tickets cost so much more than movie tickets.

All right folks, here's what we're gonna do. You know what jazz scat singing is, right? All right, well, this is Yiddish scat singing. At the right time, I want you to repeat after me.

(BUDDY ad libs Yiddish scat singing and the audience responds)

All right, now what we're gonna do—I'm gonna cut you right in half—it'll be like an Orthodox wedding. When I point to you with my right hand, you repeat after me. Left hand, you repeat after me. Here we go...

(More Yiddish scat and audience response.)

I'M GLAD I BROUGHT A LITTLE JOY THAT RHYMES WITH GOY!

Thank you! This is why I love the Catskills!

7. Until Now

BUDDY

ALWAYS HAD THE DREAM FROM AN EARLY AGE TO BE CRACKING WISE ON THE CENTER STAGE, BUT I NEVER THOUGHT I'D GET THERE UNTIL NOW.

SURE, I HAD THE WILL AND I HAD THE DRIVE, BUT WHO KNEW THAT I WOULD FEEL SO ALIVE? DIDN'T KNOW THAT I COULD KILL 'EM UNTIL NOW!
